- **Support the decisions, goals, policies and procedures made by the coach** in accordance with the Creekview Cheer Constitution, even when it does not fall in the favor of your specific child.
- **Encourage your child to try** their best at all times. There will be tough practices/competitions/decisions/days, and your child needs 1. a place to vent 2. a cheerleader 3. sound advice that is in support of the program, coaches and your athlete.
- **Review and sign the constitution** with your child and be sure they understand there will be consequences for unacceptable behaviors. Cheerleaders must abide by the Creekview Competition Cheerleading Constitution throughout the school year.
- **Teach your child to be responsible and punctual by helping them be on time in appropriate attire with all required items.**
- **Enthusiastically attend athletic functions** to show your support. Parents are expected to sit together to cheer on all Creekview Cheerleading teams and display positive sportsmanship towards other teams.
- **Read and respond to all emails** (when applicable) that concern your cheerleader/manager. Please turn on your band notifications.

- **Refrain from expressing *any* negativity** regarding Creekview Cheerleading, or Georgia High School Association on social media or in the community. We can not tolerate parents speaking negatively about any athlete , parent, or coach. This undermines the team.
- **Participate** in all fundraising activities.
- **Volunteer** in areas where you can make a difference, and we can keep the program running effectively. Volunteer hours are needed at various fundraising events and in the program committees. (We cannot run this program without parental/family volunteers).
- **Respect the competition** and all officials regardless of the outcome.
- **Learn and understand the scoring system** so you can help know areas of growth for your athlete and the Creekview Cheer Program.
- **Parent/Cheerleader concerns and individual coach meetings** must be scheduled in advance and not during practice. When communicating/requesting a meeting with coaches, parents/cheerleaders must include the team head coach in all communication and allow 2 business days for a response.

By signing this document, you agree to uphold the rules and expectations of this program for the entire season. If you break this agreement, your athlete will be subject to the consequence policy or removal from the team/position.

Please understand that this is a working document that is updated accordingly and while it is a broad overview of expectations and standards for the program, it cannot encompass all situations/circumstances. The coaches have full discretion to decisions made as it pertains to the competition cheerleading program.
